Sangiovese is Tuscany's Chianti star variety and much loved here also across many regions from the Alpine Valleys to Barossa and beyond. This has been crafted from two clones of the variety that offer top notes of one contrasting with deeper, earthy, bass lines of the other. There's fennel bush, all spice, black tea, raspberry leaf and cherry and pomegranate juice, all dusted with fine minerally feels and delightfully lifted flavour in the finish
